### Who are we?

We are the Deddington and Parish Covid-19 response team.

### Why have we formed?

Our purpose is to co-ordinate information and action between Government agencies, local businesses, The Church, Deddington News, Deddington Parish Council, Deddington Medical facilities and ALL citizens of Deddington Parish.

We live in the Parish and have agreed to help co-ordinate a community response to the virus. We are unpaid volunteers who are not professional pandemic experts. We have not received training for this role.

However, we are community-focused, dedicated and action-driven individuals who are standing up to meet the needs of our community.

We do NOT have special powers, access to mega funds or reserves of supplies but we are trying to co-ordinate those things for all those in need.

### What can you expect from Zone Captains?

What we have worked out so far:

- Keeping ourselves safe and healthy (we are identifying 2nd and 3rd people for back up)
- Processing your requests for assistance by:
  - Assessing the request (is this something we can or should be doing?)
  - Connecting you to the latest information and resources
  - Taking action where needed and sharing that action across the group
- Being the voice of support in what is a stressful time
- Allocating specific roles to captains (connections to shops, medical services, council etc)
- Maintaining a list of those of you who are vulnerable or key workers who need support (contact your Zone Captain and let them know if you are in this group)

Call the number for your zone as shown below

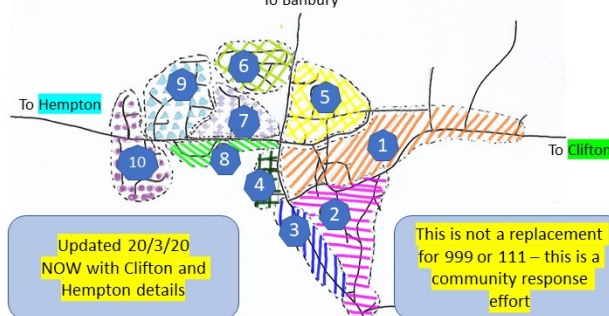
### Deddington COVID-19 Response
