

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OF DEDDINGTON PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON 12TH MAY, 1982

Present: Councillors Mrs. Cheeseman, Fuller, Gardner, Garrett, Garvey, George, Hayward, Mackenzie, Marshall, O'Neill, Mrs. Robinson, Stevens, Ward and Webber.

1. To elect a Chairman for the ensuing year It was moved by Councillor Gardner, seconded by Councillor Mrs. Robinson and unanimously RESOLVED that Councillor Ward be elected Chairman of the Council for the ensuing year. Councillor Ward then signed his Declaration of Acceptance of Office & took the Chair.
2. To elect a Vice Chairman for the ensuing year It was moved by Councillor Garrett, seconded by Councillor Gardner and unanimously RESOLVED that Councillor Mrs. Robinson be elected Vice Chairman of the Council for the ensuing year.
3. Minutes of the Meeting of the Council held on 28th April, 1982, which had been previously circulated, were confirmed as a true record and signed by the Chairman, after the insertion of the word "quote" had been made at the end of the fifth line of minute 7.
4. Matters arising from the Minutes

Planning applications This matter was further discussed especially in relation to Castle End and the Clerk reported on correspondence he had had with the Chief Planning and Development Officer. RESOLVED that, in future, copies of the agenda of the Planning Sub-Committee of the District Council be obtained. FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Councillor be invited to attend an early meeting of the Council to have a general discussion with a view to a good working relationship being set up for the term of office.

Castle Grounds The question of mole extermination was deferred until the next meeting.
5. Result of the Election The Clerk reported on the result of the Election, which was uncontested, as set out in the appendix to these Minutes. He also reported that all Members had made the necessary Declaration of Acceptance of Office.
6. Dates and times of Meetings RESOLVED that Meetings be held on the fourth Wednesday in each month at 7.15 p.m., but that further consideration be given to the date of the December meeting in November.
7. Membership of Committees RESOLVED that, with the exception of the Planning Committee, all standing committees be discontinued. FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the Planning Committee be the Chairman, Vice Chairman, and Councillors Garrett, Stevens and O'Neill. Also RESOLVED that the Vice Chairman be appointed to replace Mr. Spencer on the group advising on the Windmill Community Centre.
8. OALC Annual General Meeting RESOLVED that Councillor George be appointed to attend this meeting with the Clerk.

9. Planning applications No objections were made to the following planning applications:-


CHN.207/82 Coach house, The Hermitage, Market Place;

10. Market stall A verbal application was received from Mr. R. After some discussion, RESOLVED that permission be granted at a charge of £1 for this occasion, subject to Mr. West obtaining all necessary consents, being responsible for any third party claims, and leaving the site in a clean and tidy condition before he leaves it.
