

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF DEDDINGTON PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON 25TH JULY, 1984

Present: Councillor Mrs. Robinson (Chairman), Councillors Mrs. Cheeseman, Fenemore, Fuller, Garrett, Garvey, Hayward, Mackenzie, O'Neill, Stevens, Ward and Webber.

Apologies for absence were submitted on behalf Councillors Gardner and George.

1. Minutes of the Meeting of the Council held on 27th June, 1984, which had been previously circulated, were confirmed as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

2. Matters arising from the Minutes

Highway danger at Clifton It was reported that the resiting of the 30 mph signs would be reported to the next meeting of the County Traffic and Works Sub-Committee with the recommendation that it be given low priority.

Circus at Castle Grounds It was reported that the circus had performed and paid the fee due. Arising therefrom, Councillor Garrett undertook to see that the District Council collected the rubbish left.

Polling station It was reported that the Returning Officer would be looking at polling arrangements later in the year.

"Blott on the Landscape" The Chairman gave further details of the filming arrangements and that the Corporation had offered the Council £4500 for the Windmill Community Centre. She undertook to see that the toilets in the Town Hall were smartened up for use by the people in the filming.

Castle Grounds RESOLVED that the condition of the grass around the play-ground equipment be drawn to the attention of the contractor.

3. Items of correspondence

Liaison with Parish Authorities RESOLVED that the Chairman and Councillor Mrs. Cheeseman attend the meeting on 6th September, but that no matter be referred to the District Council for prior consideration.

Town Hall decoration It was noted that this work had not yet been carried out owing to the lack of community service workers.

Listed Building Review It was noted that this review would be undertaken in August 1986 and RESOLVED that all Members be given a copy of the List.

Footway in New Street The dangerous state of the footway outside Mallards was noted and referred to the Area County Surveyor with the request that he attend ~~a future meeting of the Council~~ to discuss highway maintenance generally.

Market stall It was noted that Deddington Ladies had been given permission to have a stall on 28th July.

4. Windmill Community Centre

New hall It was reported that negotiations were nearly complete and that verbal notification had been given that the District Council had made a grant of £3625 or 25% of the cost, whichever is less.

Playgroup land The Clerk reported that, subject to Committee consent, the County Council were prepared to sell a seven-foot six inches strip of land for £150, provided the Council arranged to erect a child-proof fence for the Playgroup. He had asked the Playgroup secretary to obtain the wishes of her Committee on the type and line of the fence and awaited a reply.

Children's Fair A request to hold a fair was referred to the Windmill committee for a decision.

5. Planning Committee It was reported that the Committee had made no objections to (a) a new door unit at a shop in New Street; (b) change of use to a garden centre at The Little House, Clifton Road; or (c) a dwelling at Chapmans Lane subject to a satisfactory access being made to Chapmans Lane. (d) It was considered that part of the proposed development at Pumpyard Cottage, New Street overlooked properties to the east.
