Purchase of Exclusive Rights Privacy Notice

When you purchase the Exclusive Right to a single or joint cemetery plot, information you provide (personal information such as name, address, email address, phone number) will be processed and stored so that it is possible to contact you and to respond to your correspondence relating to your burial plot/s. Your personal information will not be shared with any third party without your prior consent.

The Councils Right to Process Information

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) Article 6 (1) (a) (b) and (c) (Data Protection Act 2018)

Processing is with consent of the data subject

or

Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation

or

Processing is necessary for the performance of a contract with the data subject or to take steps to enter into a contract

Information Security

Deddington Parish Council is aware of the need to ensure the security of personal data. We make sure that your information is protected from unauthorised access, loss, manipulation, falsification, destruction or unauthorised disclosure. This is done through appropriate technical measures and relevant policies.

We will only keep your data for the purpose it was collected for and only for as long as is necessary, after which it will be deleted.

Your Rights

Access to Information

Information Correction

Please note:

Deddington Parish Council has an obligation to retain the personal details of owners of Exclusive Rights for burial.

This also includes cemetery information detailing the names of those buried or to be buried in the future within its burial grounds.

Right to Object

Rights Related to Automated Decision Making and Profiling

Deddington Parish Council does not use automated decision making or profiling of personal data.

To Sum Up

In accordance with the law, we only collect a limited amount of information about you that is necessary for correspondence, our information and service provision. We do not use profiling, we do not sell or pass your data to third parties. We do not use your data for purposes other than those specified. We make sure your data is stored securely. We delete all information deemed to be no longer necessary. We constantly review our Privacy Policies to keep it up to date in protecting your data.
